

Two courses in period five have an entry requirement, which means that you may not follow the course if you do not fulfill the requirement.

- For the course *Statistics II (IPN2028 / PSY2028)*, a pass for *Statistics I* is required.
- For the course *Research Practical (IPN2027 / PSY2027)*, a pass for *Statistics I* and a pass for *Methods and Techniques* are required.

Missing requirement: pass for *Statistics I*

As far as we know, you still need a pass for *Statistics I (IPN1024 / PSY1024)* to meet the entry requirement.

According to the Exam and Education regulation, these requirements have to be met on 15 March 2022 - the so-called 'reference date' - which is before the resit of *Statistics I*, on 5 April 2022.

The Board of Examiners (BoE) decided to allow conditional course bookings. And the reference date for the entry requirement 'a pass for *Statistics I*' has been moved backward (delayed) by four weeks.

While waiting for the outcome of the resit for *Statistics I*, you can already take part in *Statistics II* and/or *Research Practical* this academic year.

Action required!

Mention this email and write that you would like a conditional course booking for *Statistics II* and/or *Research Practical*. Please submit your request before 18 March 2022.

After the resit...

We expect the results of the resit in the first or second week of period five.

If you pass the resit of *Statistics I*, the 'conditional booking' changes to a regular booking. Should you fail the resit, your conditional booking will be cancelled. This means that you may not continue taking the course from that moment on.
