

# Weekly update on FPN Education | 10 April

Dear FPN students,

We hope you are well and that you're getting more or less used to education online. For those of you that took course exams this week and last week, we hope you were successful and did not encounter any major problems in taking the online exams. # **EXAM PERIOD 4 (bachelor's programme)**

Coordinators of courses in the Bachelor programme Period 4 (Development, Perception, Consciousness, Man & Machine, Statistics III, Methods of Cognitive Neuroscience) have decided on the exam format. Either you've already been informed, or you'll be informed shortly about the chosen exam format through the course environment (Student Portal).

Concerning exam grading, except for Statistics III, the other five bachelor courses of period 4 will be graded with either a pass or fail. This means that these 5 courses do not count towards your GPA and also cannot be used for compensation. It's a decision that takes notice of the sudden change to online education at the end of period 4, the packed exam schedule early June, and the chosen formats of the exams by the coordinators. For period 5, the bachelor courses will revert to traditional grading from 1-10 except for History that will use pass/fail.

In year 1, development and perception will have an assignment as the course exam. Students can already start working on it for the course development, and soon for the perception course. The deadline for handing in the assignment for both courses is 12 June at 17.00 hrs. This will thus help you in spreading the study load, also in light of the course exams for period 5 the week before (1-5 June) and the resits for periods 2 and 3 the week after (15-19 June).

#### **BACHELOR THESIS**

The deadline for the Bachelor thesis is 17 April 2020 at 13.00 hrs, see AskPsy. This deadline will not be postponed. Please, make sure that you hand in your bachelor thesis on time viaDorsWebApp. The system will close immediately after the deadline has passed. Missing the deadline for the final version implies you are not allowed to finish your bachelor thesis in the current academic year.

#### RESEARCH AND CLINICAL INTERNSHIP STUDENTS

We would like to thank all students that took the time to fill in the surveys that asked about the progress of your internship and any problems you face. The large majority of students responded. Currently, our staff members and policy advisors are drafting a short report to be presented to the Faculty Board, who will discuss the outcomes and decide on possible actions.

#### PARTICIPATION IN EDUCATION

As we communicated earlier, collaborating is an important part of our PBL education. Given the current special circumstances, the attendance requirement has been abolished to prevent sick students, students caring for relatives, or students that cannot attend education because of other circumstances to get in trouble. All other students are expected to actively participate in online tutorials and other education. After all, we're all in this together! Tutors have received instructions on activities they can do to make you quickly feel part of the group. Try them out, together!
