Internship: in curriculum

Period 1: Sept-Okt. → 2 courses

Period 2: Nov-Dec → 2 courses

Period 3: Academic Skills & Research proposal

Then: **RESEARCH INTERNSHIP**

→ if prerequisites are met

→ From Period 4 (February) to ~July

Assessment of master thesis

You need **2 supervisors**

1 is always from FPN

1st supervisor has PhD degree (or is advanced phd student)

In external institute:

→ If external supervisor has PhD degree:

→ Then he/she is/can be the 1st supervisor. Make sure they know their responsibilities, see:

→ You need a second assessor from FPN

Arranging your internship

- Arranged by the HSP master
- Arranged by yourself

COVID-19

- An internship abroad is only allowed on condition that
 - 1) the Dutch government's travel advice classifies the destination green or yellow and
 - 2) your host institution confirms that it can physically facilitate the internship.
- Do not travel to countries with code orange/red without permission of FPN.
- Update on COVID-19 policy will be communicated regularly via askpsy
- Be alert, and during internship in case of lockdown, contact supervisors
- Make a plan B

Arranging an internship by yourself

- Start in time
- External supervisor:
 - Needs to hold a PhD
 - Needs to be aware of the responsibilities of supervision (see slide 4 for link)
- Need a second supervisor from FPN, keep in contact with FPN supervisor
- Make an appointment with Ghislaine Schyns

Step 3: Apply for internship

- Nov 12
- E-mail motivation and internship request
- E-mail only one supervisor!

Step 4: Fill out the online application form

- This is crucial for your internship to be valid.
- [online application form](#)
- This the basis of the contract, that needs to be signed before the internship starts.

Internship contract

- Important!
- Your internship should be legal
- Have you met all requirements?
- Your internship is insured
- No application form = no contract
= no valid internship = no EC
